

Springdale Veterans Memorial embraces life and the freedom that the veterans fought to protect while honoring their sacrifices. Rather than creating a place that is solemn and contemplative in its entirety, Springdale Veterans Memorial carefully blends a series of contemplative moments within a larger landscape experience. The memorial, therefore, becomes a journey. The visitors are drawn in from a meandering path

The visitors are drawn in from a meandering path into Passage of Light where they are fully immersed by words and phrases of courage, hope, and freedom. At the end of the dark pathway, visitors enter a light-filled courtyard-like garden, Plateau of Life. The Plateau takes cues from the karstic landform of the Ozarks and balances rugged rocks with softs grasses and trees to create an inhabitable landscape. The Plateau is held in

place by Veterans Wall, where the names of veterans that served are engraved on metal walls. Veterans Wall acts as a retaining wall that holds up Plateau of Life.



Distributed along this meandering path through a grass field are various sizes of stone pavement tiles that have names of donors engraved. Springdale Veterans Memorial is a living space.






